On Friday, May 7, 2021 I, Officer Jessica Priestly was working a uniformed patrol shift 1600-0000 hours in marked cruiser #35. I was assigned to patrol the Intown sector of Middleborough. At approximately 1807 hours, myself and Officer Savage, in marked cruiser #46 were dispatched to Middleborough for a report of a male party. Dispatch then advised that the male party may be [redacted] While traveling on Center Street, preparing to turn onto [redacted] with Brewster Ambulance, Officer Savage advised over the air that the bathroom was on the second floor and that he had [redacted]

Myself and Brewster personnel entered the front door of the home and ascended the staircase to where Officer Savage and the male party were located. I observed a white male [redacted] I immediately provided Officer Savage with my [redacted] for the male party. Due to the limited space and medical staff on scene with a higher degree of medical competency and ability, I stepped back so that they could assume care of the male party. Brewster personnel continued to provide care to the male party while I descended the stairs to speak with the reporting party.

Upon going downstairs, I observed a female party sitting in the living room crying hysterically. I introduced myself to her at which time she identified herself as [redacted] D.O.B. [redacted] I asked [redacted] who the male party was to which she identified him as MATTHEW KELLEY (D.O.B. [redacted] When asked what her relationship was to Mr. Kelley she advised that it was her boyfriend. [redacted] advised that they have been dating for years now. [redacted] was extremely upset while we spoke at which time I advised her she did exactly what she needed to do to get him the best care as soon as possible.

I asked [redacted] to tell me exactly what happened this evening. [redacted] advised that Mr. Kelly came home from work at approximately 1800 hours. [redacted] stated that she had her two dogs outside in the back yard when Mr. Kelley arrived home. [redacted] advised that Mr. Kelley approached her and advised that he was going to use the bathroom [redacted] advised shortly after she entered the home with the dogs and noticed that Mr. Kelley was still in the bathroom [redacted] stated that she then heard an odd sound, advising that it sounded like the dogs may have been growling [redacted] then advised that she then thought maybe it was Mr. Kelley

Approximately 30 minutes later, Sergeant Ferbert advised that per the Chief, Joseph Perkins, I was to return to the scene and secure it until Massachusetts State Police personnel could arrive on scene and take over the investigation. I arrived on scene with Massachusetts State Trooper Darosa. At this time I observed

At this time I cleared this information with Sergeant Ferbert who advised I could clear the scene. At this time the incident remains under investigation by the Massachusetts State Police.
